Many Springdale Roads in Need of Repair

The city of Springdale is calling it "The year of the Patch," because so many roads are in need of repair after all the bad winter weather.

Street crews found 35 to 40 damaged spots. In some cases that means an entire road needs paved, while in others a pothole or a couple cracks need patched.

The city says every year they see damage, but this year it's twice as bad. With all the freezing weather, concrete was splitting everywhere.

The three major trouble spots are Huntsville Avenue near Elmdale Shopping Center, Randal Wobbe Lane near the railroad tracks and Lakeview Drive near Springdale Country Club.

People who live near these areas say the road work can't come soon enough. "I drive down this road every day, there are potholes everywhere, it damages my car," said Julian Carnell, who lives off Hylton Road, one of many streets that is getting paved.

The projects are expected to be completed over the next two years.
